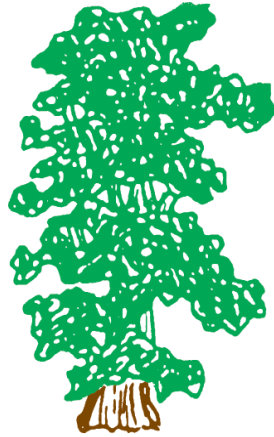
Friday 21st July - Reception children back in Reception classes for last two days.

Topics

Current topic- Dinosaurs and Transition to year 1.

Targets for Term 5

Writing

- I can start some of my words with the correct sound.
- I can form my letters correctly.
- I can write my surname.
- I can write a sentence in a group.
- I can read what I have written.
- I can write some simple words and sentences.

NUMERACY

- I can select the correct number to represent group's of objects from 1-20
- I can count accurately up to 20 and beyond
- I can recognise numbers up to 20.
- I can write my numbers to 20
- I can say what number is one more or one less than a given number up to 20.
- I can add and subtract with numbers 1-20.
- I can recognise 2D and 3D shapes.
- I can double, half and share objects and numbers.

Foundation children will be learning to:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- To start to compromise and find ways to solve problems between each other.
- To negotiate with friends over shared resources..
- To talk about changes and prepare for year one transition.

Language, Literacy and Communication

- Write for different purposes e.g. postcard
- Write a recount of visit to Gulliver's
- Continue to write sounds heard in words
- Write tricky words from memory
- Begin to use full stops and capital letters in their writing.
- Speak confidently in a group, starting to include details.

Mathematical Development

- Recognise and start to write numbers zero to twenty.
- Add and subtract using a range of strategies.
- Compare quantities
- Solve Problems
- Begin to recognise differences in coins.
- Sequence the day & begin to recognise o'clock.

Understanding the World

- Use beebot and programmable toys.
- To find dinosaur facts from the internet and non-fiction books.
- To notice similarities and differences between different dinosaurs.
- To learn the vocabulary 'carnivore' and 'herbivore'
- To remember special times and events with their families and talk about them to their friends and teachers.

Physical Development

- Do athletics activities, including running races and throwing games.
- Take part in races and team games on Sports Day
- Understand how exercise helps keep you healthy
- Shape materials such as clay.
- Hold a pencil correctly with good pressure and control.
