## Writing Activities

### Main activities:

#### Activity 1

Watch the video story of [Pirates love underpants](#)


Talk to your child about the story

-Who are the characters in the story?

-What happened in the story?

-What did the Pirates go to find?

Your child's task this week is to draw and label their own treasure map. They are to think about the treasure it is they are going to find e.g. in the story they were going to find the golden pants and what they might meet along the way e.g. crocodiles, sharks, caves etc.



#### Activity 2

Ahoy me hearties! Your child is to imagine that they are stuck on an island and they need help, send out a message in a bottle to ask other pirates for help.

Or, they can send a message home to their family because they have been on a boat for so long and they are missing them! See attached resources.

#### Main activities:


#### Activity 1

Using objects from around the house/outside can your child complete a repeating pattern. Start with 2 different objects and then to make the repeating pattern more challenging introduce more objects. Once secure with repeating patterns can your child make their own pattern using different objects from around the house/outside



#### Activity 2

Pirate Bill needs your help Your child is to complete the repeating patterns on the stripy scarves for Pirate Bill and his friends. See attached resources




### **Practise of sounds flash cards**

### **Blending and Segmenting practise**

- [Buried Treasure](#)- your child is to read the words and workout if the word is real or fake.
- **Phonics Bootcamp**- on small pieces of paper write some numbers in words and on paper strips write some simple

exercises suitable for children to try and do. Then create a simple workout sheet on A4 paper.



Fold up the pieces of paper and put all the numbers in one pot and the exercises in another.

- Your child picks a number and an exercise in order to fill up the spaces on the sheet. They have now created their Phonics Bootcamp workout. They read through the words and captions and complete the exercise. The number can be the number of repetitions, for example 'ten star jumps' or can be the number of seconds they have to do the exercise for, i.e. 'six seconds of quick feet'. Once they've finished they can fold the paper back up again and place them back in the pot ready for another day. Adapt the numbers and exercises to make it suitable for the phase your child is working in.

# Learning projects throughout the week

## Understanding the world-

### Make a Pirate Boat

Using materials, you have got at home e.g. corks, sponges, plastic bottles etc can you make a pirate boat with your child that will float and test it to see if does float. Talk to your child about the materials and why they might not be/or might be suitable to make a pirate boat.



### Pirate Ship

Your child is to create/design their own pirate ship. **This will be set as a 2do task on Purple Mash.**



## Creative

### Design your own Pirate Pants

Create your own pirate pants using paint, glitter, pens, pencils- any resources/materials you have got at home. See attached a template for your child to colour and cut out or you can make your own.



### Pirate Telescope

Your child is to create their own telescope to help them search for their treasure. Using a tube e.g. kitchen roll tube or template provided, they can decorate the tube however they wish. They could add a repeating pattern to their telescope, linked to their maths learning this week.
