Where does he go after visiting Sophie's house? Write a story about another adventure that he has. ❖ Activity 2 Imagine if a different animal came to tea. How would they behave? Could you write a story about this? - Imagine you are Sophie, make a shopping list of all of the things that the Tiger ate and drank that you will need to replace. - Who would you like to invite for a tea party? Create an invitation for them including the date, time and place and decorate with pictures of food and drink you would have.

Learning projects to be done throughout the week

1. Design a label for a tin of Tiger Food. Think about what goes on a pet food tin. (Ingredients, best before date, name of food etc) You could stick the label onto a tin that you have already got in the cupboard just in case the tiger ever comes to tea at your house!



2. Make a Tiger mask and act out the story of The Tiger Who Came To Tea



3. Have a tea party with some of the animals (toys) from your Bedroom. You could make invitations to send to your family or the Tiger himself! Decorate biscuits to look like tigers or see what other imaginative Tiger food you can come up with! You could wear your mask and be the Tiger!

4. Look at the tiger's stripes. Find out what camouflage is and how it helps tigers.

Draw/paint /chalk/college a tiger camouflage picture. Make your background stripy like a tiger. Cut out a tiger and colour it the same colours and stripes. Stick the Tiger onto the background.



5. Make a healthy meal for the tiger and Sophie to eat together. Make sure you include plenty of fruit and veg! You can use whatever you like collage materials/ plastic food or cut out a circle of white paper to be the plate and draw on the healthy food.
