(Aim to do 1 per day)


-Read a variety of books at home. Your child should read every day if possible. You can read your own books or use:

#### Weekly Phonics tasks


(Aim to do 1 per day)

(Aim to do 1 per day)


- Talk to a grown up and find out what you need to do to plant a seed.



- Cut out the pictures, mix them up and then put them in the right order. Then, Can you write some instructions using the words, First, next, then, after that and finally underneath? E.G. First put some soil into a pot. Next add some seeds.
- Choose a plant, tree or flower, can you write 6 facts about it? Can you draw a picture of it?
