A survey was carried out with each class to gather ideas about what is working well and what students enjoy the most.



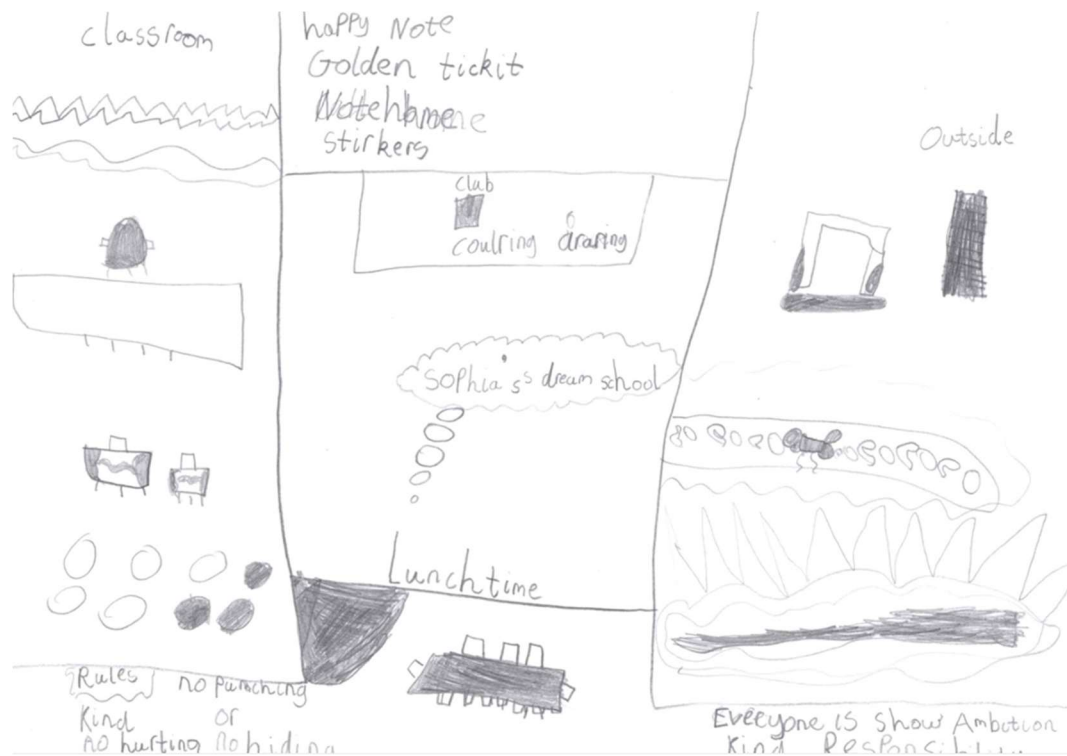
Activities

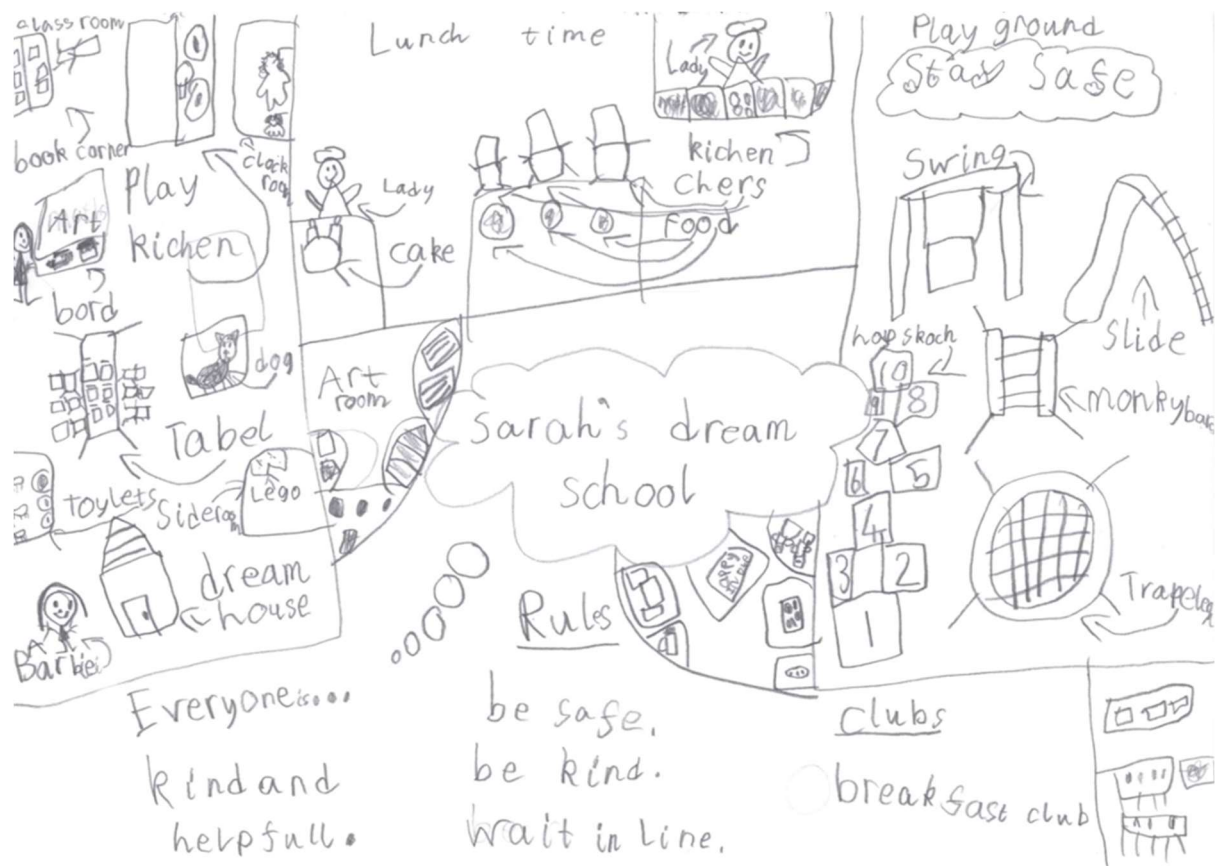
The survey showed that LEGO and art were the most popular activities. Computers and maths challenges were also enjoyed.
